- Rediscovering Faith is for those living with a mix of faith and doubt. Come and explore how we live with these tensions.

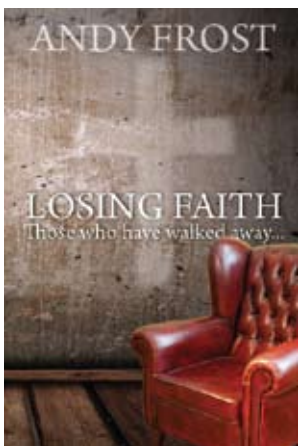
For each new person entering through the front door of the church, several are slipping quietly out the back – and may be lost to God forever.

The Rediscovering Faith Tour is based on Andy's new book *Losing Faith*. The book focuses on his reflections and research with those who have either lost or struggled with their Christian faith.
